The Florence Melton Adult Mini-School is an innovative adult Jewish learning program that provides the opportunity to achieve basic Jewish literacy in just two years. Students of varying backgrounds form a community of learners who explore Jewish texts and begin to understand how Judaism developed and what Judaism means to them. The pluralistic approach fosters an atmosphere of warmth, respect, and mutual understanding.

As Melton students say, Melton is...

- Learning from one another while exploring original source texts, both ancient and modern
- Learning the “whys” of everything Jewish from inspired teachers in a relaxed but focused environment
- Discussing various perspectives in a non-judgmental environment












The Curriculum

Engaging and eye-opening, the curriculum was developed and is constantly revised by a team of scholars at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Classes integrate Jewish history, law, beliefs, practices, ideas and terminology through the study of texts—from ancient to contemporary. Instructors are experienced educators, trained to teach adults representing all segments of the Jewish community.



The Program

Classes meet once a week for 30 weeks, beginning in the fall. Each session consists of two one-hour classes, with a short break. Although there are no prerequisites, exams, or grades, participants are asked to make a serious commitment to regular study. Students register for one year at a time, and those who complete the full two-year program earn a Certificate of Jewish Learning from The Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

MELTON Year One

RHYTHMS

What are the ideas, beliefs, and sources that shape Jewish life and practice, including the daily, weekly, monthly, annual life-cycle observances and customs?

PURPOSES

Why do Jews believe what they do, and what are the theological concepts that unfold in the Bible, the Talmud, and other sacred texts—both ancient and contemporary?

MELTON Year Two

ETHICS

An exploration of Jewish ethical foundations through the study of ancient and modern sources. Topics include: justice, life and death, marriage and interpersonal relationships, medical and business ethics, and sexuality.

DRAMAS

What are the events, trends, and movements that have shaped our people's history and development throughout the ages? What are the important highlights and watersheds from biblical times until today?

MELTON Graduate School

Graduates of the core two-year curriculum are eligible to continue their study in our Post Melton program, which offers a wide array of topics taught by dynamic and knowledgeable instructors.
