Communication

What should I expect once I enroll?

In June you will receive a welcome packet. The welcome packet will include packing lists, menu samples and other guides for the summer of 2016.

How do I contact camp?

What is the communication like from camp during the summer?

Towards the beginning of camp, we will give you access to our private camp website. Our website will include pictures and information about our daily activities.

Can I tour TEKI before camp starts or visit when my child is there?

We provide scheduled tours. Tours can be arranged within 48 hours of request.

Camp Groups & Staff

What is your camper to counselor ratio?

The ratio between camper to counselor is 6:1. Group leaders are certified teachers that teach and guide our groups through the day. Additionally, our camp counselors assist the group leaders and camp groups.

My child is younger than entering second grade, but your camp seems like a perfect fit. What should we do?

We work closely with all of the JCC Metrowest summer camps. Exploration Camp is a great way to expose Kindergarten and 1st Grade students to TEKI.

My child is entering high school, but your camp seems like a perfect fit. What should we do?

Give us a call. Maybe they would be a good fit for our LIT program.

Can my child be assigned to a group with their friends?

Instructional lessons will be divided by a camper's grade level and we will be able to accommodate friend requests based on certain criteria. Our certified teachers are able to adjust to all different levels of learning in a class. Our top priority is to build camper confidence and enrich their learning. Maturity and socialization are important factors in this process. Children will reunite as a whole for all other recreational activities.

Food & Wellness

What do campers eat at camp?

The JCC is a kosher and nut-free facility. Included in our cost is catered lunch daily under these guidelines.

What if my child has allergies that require special attention?

Our staff members have CPR, First-Aid and Epi-Pen training. The JCC Metrowest is a nut-free facility, so all food served is monitored. Please make us aware of any allergies.

Activities & Equipment

Will my child miss information if they skip a week?

TEKI camp is designed to be a weekly thematic speciality camp, so a camper will feel welcomed any week they start. We understand that campers and their families have other commitments and we try to accommodate your needs. We do offer a discounted rate if you sign up for all 8 weeks.

What if my child isn't interested in a particular weeks theme?

We will work with all campers to help them to explore new interests to the best of their abilities. We understand that not everyone enjoys every topic. We can make adjustments to the topics and subjects and arrange for alternative project-based activities.

Do you limit screen time?

Fortunately, our camp is located in a state-of-the-art facility that offers space for indoor and outdoor activities. We provide swim and recreational time in the gym and outside. Additionally, our projects are collaborative and students work together to solve problems.

Can my child bring their personal device?

We provide all of the equipment, but if your child would like to bring their personal device they are welcome to. TEKI and/or the JCC are not responsible for these devices.

Is swimming mandatory?

Swimming is not mandatory; however, it is encouraged. Our program provides a free swim period in the JCC's heated indoor pool. Instructional swim can be provided for a fee through the JCC Metrowest's Aquatic Department. Please contact us for more information.



Are there any camp trips?
